Unfortunately, myths about home visiting sometimes discourage families from taking advantage of this valuable support.

We explore some of the most common below.

MYTH: Home visiting programs are for families with problems.

TRUTH: Home visiting programs are intended for ALL families regardless of any difficulties they may o may not be having.

MYTH: Home visits are time consuming.


TRUTH: Home visiting programs offer services at a time that is convenient for you. On average, a home visit takes about an hour and happens once or twice a month.

MYTH: Home visiting programs are only for new parents.

TRUTH: Home visiting is not about teaching you how to be a parent. It is about having a knowledgeable professional support you on your parenting journey and help you reach your goals, whatever they may be.

MYTH: Home visiting programs are used by welfare and immigration agencies to monitor parents.

TRUTH: Home visitors do not report any information families share with them to welfare or immigration agencies.






THE CONNECTION
