Find Your Roar Advocacy Workgroup

## Dear Changemaker,

On behalf of Melinated Moms and Advocates for Children of New Jersey (ACNJ), we want to congratulate you and welcome you aboard the Parent Leadership Council as a *Social Impact Speaker*, made possible by the **Find Your Roar**© training course.

It was amazing getting to know you and seeing your enthusiasm to become a Parent Advocate and finding your roar! We are excited to be a part of your professional development through our organizations.

You have completed the first phase of our advocacy work, so now, we are progressing to the next phase. You will be required to attend our monthly workgroup with the Leadership Team, comprised of Melinated Moms and ACNJ staff, to discuss Four Areas of Focus, as outlined by the Pritzker Children's Initiative: (1) Quality, Affordable Child Care, (2) Maternal Health, (3) Infant and Toddler Mental Health, and (4) Home Visitation. The deliverables will vary each month based on the topic of our group discussion. In an effort to create accountability and consistency, we have established the following expectations for group participation:

- 1. **Community Engagement:** Community engagement is the top priority for the Parent Leadership Council. We believe creating social impact is rooted in social awareness. Our dedication to social impact issues faced by our community is one of the unique traits of our Five Principles of Engagement. We invite you to learn to use your voice as a social impact speaker. Through research and advocacy, you will activate your community and be the support they want and need.
- 2. **Time and Attendance:** Our group meets every last Thursday of the month from 5:30pm 7pm. We value your time and we ask for you to make the same commitment to our fellow group members. Please arrive to our virtual meeting on time and plan to stay for the full 90 minutes. You must attend a minimum of three (3) workgroups to obtain the \$500 stipend, paid at the end of our cohort in May 2021.
- 3. **Safe Space, Speak Up.** As representatives of underheard and underserved communities, we understand how important it is to create trust through advocacy efforts. We expect all workgroup members to respect the space we have created as a safe, non-judgmental zone that encourages each community member to speak up and speak out to create change for our areas of focus.
- 4. **Communication is Key**. The cultivation of the Parent Leadership Council is rooted in communicating the needs of our community in an effective way. We expect all of our workgroup members to find their preferred method of communication (written, speaking, or recruitment) and utilize the skills obtained through our group to build a bridge of support moms centered in diversity, inclusion and equity. We expect

our workgroup to build this culture collectively from their personal experiences while learning how to see the intersections from their preferred method of communication as a tool to expand our work on a macro level.
