Attendance Matters in Preschool!

MYTH:

Absences only matter when they occur several days in a row.

REALITY:

Whether your child misses a day here and a day there, or several days in a row, everyday matters!

Preschool helps young children build early reading and math skills, as well as develop the social and emotional foundation they need to succeed in school.

Preschoolers with Good Attendance are...

- More likely to arrive at kindergarten better prepared.
- □ More likely to be able to read at grade level by 3rd grade.
- Less likely to repeat a grade.

But kids only get the full effect of these benefits if they show up to preschool regularly.



Tips for Parents:

Talk to your children: Discuss frequently why going to school is so important.

Be organized: Develop simple routines that make it easier for your kids to attend school every day, like regular bed times, and laying out their clothes the night before. Have a back-up plan: When issues arise and getting your children to school is a problem, have a "back-up" plan, like having a relative or neighbor ready to step in.
