

DIAPERNEED


 Diaper need is the lack of a sufficient supply of diapers to keep a baby clean, dry, and healthy.

It can lead to serious
 health problems for babies
 and emotional stress for
 their families.



GOVERNMENT ASSISTANCE

Diapers are not covered by government assistance programs like SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program) and WIC (Women, Infants, and Children).





NJ STATISTICS

- 299,837 children under the age of 3
- 15% of infants and toddlers living at <100% of the FPL
- 31% of infants and toddlers living at <200% of the FPL



2023 POVERTY GUIDELINES FOR THE 48 CONTIGUOUS STATES AND THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

Persons in family/household	Poverty guideline
1	\$14,580
2	\$19,720
3	\$24,860
4	\$30,000
5	\$35,140
6	\$40,280
7	\$45,420
8	\$50,560

For families/households with more than 8 persons, add \$5,140 for each additional person.

HOUSEHOLDS USING DIAPER BANKS

- 53% reported income less than \$25,000.
- 97% reported income less than \$50,000.
- 92% of families
 receiving diapers in New
 Jersey are working.




HOUSEHOLDS USING DIAPER BANKS (CONT.)

- 71% of families using childcare rely on childcare so an adult in their household can go to work.
- 1 in 10 families use childcare to allow an adult to attend school or a job training program.
