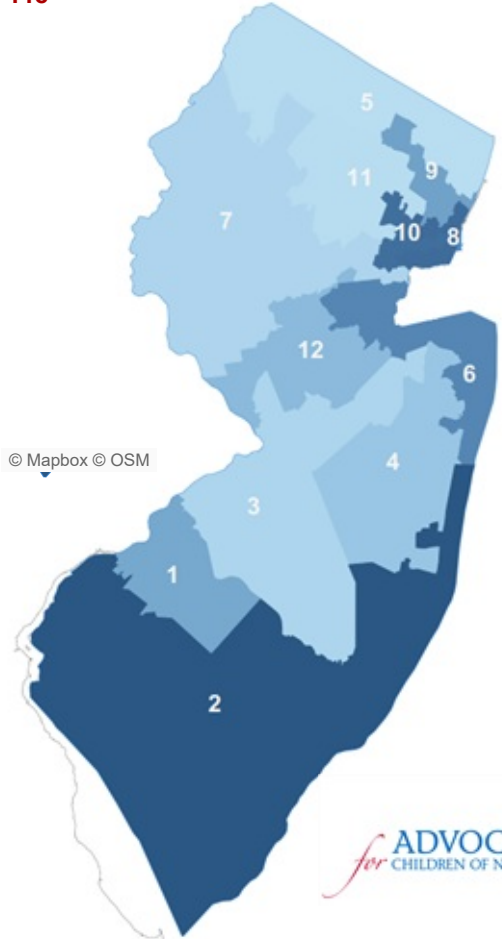

The Maternal Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV) program is the largest federal investment in voluntary home visiting, delivering evidence-based services that strengthen the parent-child relationship and connect families to vital community resources to support long-term healthy development and well-being. Home visitors meet with parents one on one from pregnancy through their child's kindergarten entry to help lay the foundation for the health, education, development that will enable home visiting programs to reach more families.

Visits by caring, experienced professionals who provide families support and connections to needed resources and services can help families leverage their strengths so they can thrive. In NJ, MIECHV funded programs, including Healthy Families, Nurse Family Partnership and Parents As Teachers, are available in all 21 counties. Learn more at Advocates for Children of New Jersey.

Home Visiting data was supplied by the NJ Department of Children and Families as of June 30th, 2025.

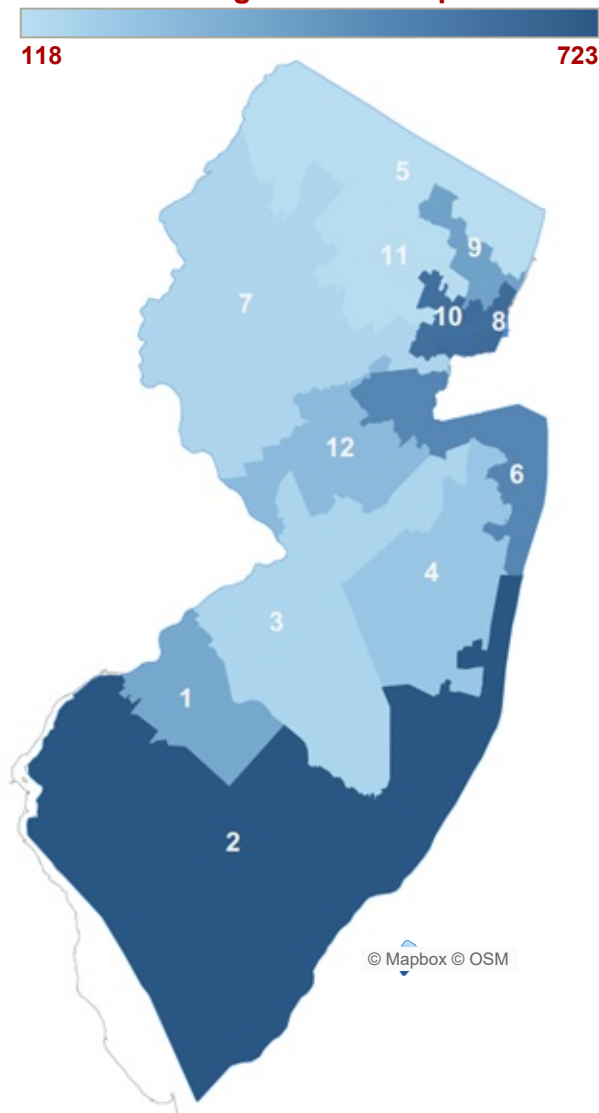
